

2019 ANWARC Gaited Class Outline Sheet

1. Open Model. (HAWHA rules) – *Heart of America Points Class.
 - a. Horse led by Handler and parked-out for judging.
 - b. Judged on Conformation and Presentation.
2. Juvenile Gaited – Walk Only. (ANWARC rules) – Riders 18 and Under
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Header allowed.
 - b. Horses shown at a Dog Walk (slow flat walk), both ways of the arena. Line up for judging, but no back.
 - c. Exhibitors showing in this class may not show in other classes at same show, except lead line, if lead line is available at the show.
3. 17 & Under Walking Horse (HAWHA rules) – Riders 17 and under *Heart of America Points Class.
 - a. English Tack, Horses are padded.
 - b. Horses shown at a Flat Walk and Running Walk. Lined up for judging, but no back.
4. Gaited Pleasure –Novice Rider (ANWARC rules)
 - a. Riders have never placed first three times prior to the current show season.
 - b. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - c. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - d. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
5. Senior Ladies Gaited Pleasure (ANWARC rules) – Riders aged 19 and over.
 - a. Qualifies rider for Arkansas State Championship in Heavy Shod Gaited Pleasure.
 - b. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - c. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - d. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
6. 4 & Under Gaited Pleasure (ANWARC rules) – Horses four years and younger.
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - b. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - c. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
7. Amateur Specialty Walking Horse (HAWHA rules). – *Heart of America Points Class.
 - a. Amateur Riders. English Tack, Horses are padded.
 - b. Horses shown at a Flat Walk and Running Walk. Lined up for judging, but no back.
8. Juvenile Gaited Pleasure (ANWARC rules) – Riders aged 18 and under.
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - b. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - c. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
9. Country Pleasure Walking Horse (HAWHA rules). – *Heart of America Points Class.
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Cavessons allowed on western horses.
 - b. Western Riders may ride two handed.
 - c. Horses shown at Flat Walk and Running Walk. Lined up for judging, must back.
 - d. Horses are flat shod. Cast or Stamped Keg Shoes only.
10. Country Pleasure Racking Horse (RHBA rules).
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - b. Horses shown at Country Pleasure Show Walk, Country Pleasure Slow Rack, Country Pleasure Fast Rack. Lined up for judging, must back.
 - c. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.

11. Lite Shod Walking Horse (HAWHA Rules). – *Heart of America Points Class.
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Cavessons not allowed on western horses.
 - b. Western riders using a shank bit must ride one-handed. (Horses four and under may wear a snaffle bit and be ridden with two hands).
 - c. Horses shown at Flat Walk and Running Walk. Lined up for judging, must back.
 - d. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size 1/2"x1".

12. Versatility – Water Glass. (ANWARC rules)
 - a. Riders must carry a water-filled glass while performing requested gaits.
 - b. Winner is rider with most water in glass at end of class.

13. 4 Year Old Walking Horse (HAWHA rules) –*Heart of America Points Class.
 - a. English Tack, Horses are padded.
 - b. Horses shown at Flat Walk and Running Walk. Lined up for judging, but no back.

14. Trail Pleasure Racking Horse (RHBA rules).
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - b. Horses enter the arena at a Trail Pleasure Rack, then will be asked for Trail Pleasure Walk and Trail Pleasure Rack. Lined up for judging, no back.
 - c. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size 1/2"x1-1/2" with bands allowed.

15. Gaited Pleasure – Novice Horse. (ANWARC rules)
 - a. Horses have never placed first three times prior to the current show season.
 - b. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - c. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - d. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size 1/2"x1-1/2" with bands allowed.

16. Senior Gentlemen's Gaited Pleasure. (ANWARC rules) – Riders aged 19 and over.
 - a. Qualifies rider for Arkansas State Championship in Heavy Shod Gaited Pleasure.
 - b. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - c. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - d. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size 1/2"x1-1/2" with bands allowed.

17. Dave Baker Trail Pleasure – Keg Shod. (ANWARC rules)
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - b. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - c. Horses are flat shod. Cast or Stamped Keg Shoes only.

18. 15.2& Under Amateur Walking Horse (HAWHA Rules) *Heart of America Points Class
Amateur Exhibitor. English Tack, Horses are padded.
 - a. Horses shown at Flat Walk and Running Walk. Lined up for judging, but no back.

- 19.. Juvenile Gaited Pleasure Championship. (ANWARC rules) – Riders 18 and under.
 - a. Riders must have qualified by being judged in an earlier Juvenile pleasure class.
 - b. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - c. Horses are shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, no back.
 - d. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size 1/2"x1-1/2" with bands allowed.

20. Speed Racking (RHBA rules)
 - a. English Tack
 - b. Horses shown at Show Walk, Slow Rack, Fast Rack. Lined up for judging, but no back.

21. Show Pleasure Walking Horse (HAWHA rules) – *Heart of America Points Class
 - a. English Tack, Horses are padded. No tail brace.
 - b. Horses are shown Flat Walk and Running Walk. Lined up for judging, no back.

22. Open Foxtrot – no canter. (ANWARC rules)
 - a. Horses enter the ring at a fox trot. Horses are shown Flat Walk and Fox Trot. Lined up for judging, no back.
23. Amateur Owned & Trained Gaited Pleasure. (ANWARC rules)
 - a. Amateur owner exhibitor. Horse cannot have been with a trainer in the past 90 days.
 - b. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - c. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, no back.
 - d. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
24. Amateur-Amateur Gaited Pleasure. (ANWARC rules)
 - a. The horse will be presented by two amateur exhibitors. Primary rider first way of the arena, and secondary rider on the reverse. Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait.
 - b. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - c. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - d. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
25. Specialty Action Open Racking. (RHBA rules)
 - a. Qualifies rider for Arkansas State Championship in Men's or Ladies Open Gaited.
 - b. English Tack. Horses are shown padded with chains or rollers.
 - c. Horses shown at a Show Walk, Slow Rack, and Fast Rack. Lined up for judging, no back.
26. Elite Rider Gaited Pleasure. (ANWARC rules) – Riders 50 and over.
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - b. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - c. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
27. Park Performance Walking Horse (HAWHA rules) - *Heart of America Points Class.
 - a. English Tack. Shod with Plantation shoes and wedges. No tail brace.
 - b. Horses are shown Flat Walk and Running Walk. Lined up for judging, no back.
28. Versatility Class - Egg & Spoon. (ANWARC rules)
 - c. Riders must carry an egg on a spoon while performing requested gaits.
 - d. Winner is rider with egg still in spoon at end of class.
29. Lite Shod Gaited Pleasure. (ANWARC rules)
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - b. Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - c. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1".
 - d. Qualifies rider for Arkansas State Championship in Lite Shod Gaited Pleasure.
30. Open Walking Horse (HAWHA rules) - *Heart of America Points Class.
 - a. Qualifies rider for Arkansas State Championship in Men's or Ladies Open Gaited.
 - b. English Tack. Horses are shown padded.
 - c. Horses shown at Flat Walk and Running Walk. Lined up for judging, but no back.
31. Trail Pleasure Walking Horse (HAWHA rules).
 - a. Optional Tack, English or Western. Cavessons not allowed on western horses.
 - b. Western riders using a shank bit must ride one-handed. (Horses four and under may wear a snaffle bit and be ridden with two hands).
 - c. Horses shown at Flat Walk and Running Walk. Trail Walk, at judge's discretion. Lined up for judging, must back.
 - d. Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size 3/8"x3/4" with bands allowed.

32. Western Gaited Pleasure. (ANWARC rules)
- Riders must use western tack and attire. No cavesson allowed.
 - Riders using a shank bit must ride one-handed. (Horses four and under may wear a snaffle bit and be ridden with two hands).
 - Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Halt on rail may be called. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
33. Flat Shod Racking Horse (RHBA rules)
- English Tack
 - Horses shown at Show Walk, Slow Rack, Fast Rack.
 - Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
34. Senior Gaited Pleasure Championship. (ANWARC rules) - Riders 19 and over.
- Exhibitors must have qualified by being judged in an earlier senior pleasure class.
 - Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
35. Open Walking Horse – Canter (HAWHA rules) - *Heart of America Points Class.
- English Tack. Horses are shown padded.
 - Horses shown at Flat Walk, Running Walk, Canter. Lined up for judging, no back.
36. Gaited Pleasure Stake. (ANWARC rules) – must be a paid ANWARC member.
- Exhibitors must have qualified by being judged in an earlier gaited pleasure class.
 - Optional Tack, English or Western. Western may ride two handed. Cavesson allowed.
 - Horses shown at Pleasure Walk and Pleasure Gait. Lined up for judging, but no back.
 - Horses are flat shod. Max shoe size ½"x1-½" with bands allowed.
